- NCVEC Form 605 must be completed by the candidate and will be provided.  
It also may be downloaded from the ARRL VEC ([www.arrl.org/arrlvec/ncvec605-3.pdf](http://www.arrl.org/arrlvec/ncvec605-3.pdf)).
- Examinees must present personal picture ID (no exceptions).
- If licensed, bring original and photocopy of current FCC license and/or CSCEs.
- Exam fee as allowed by FCC.
